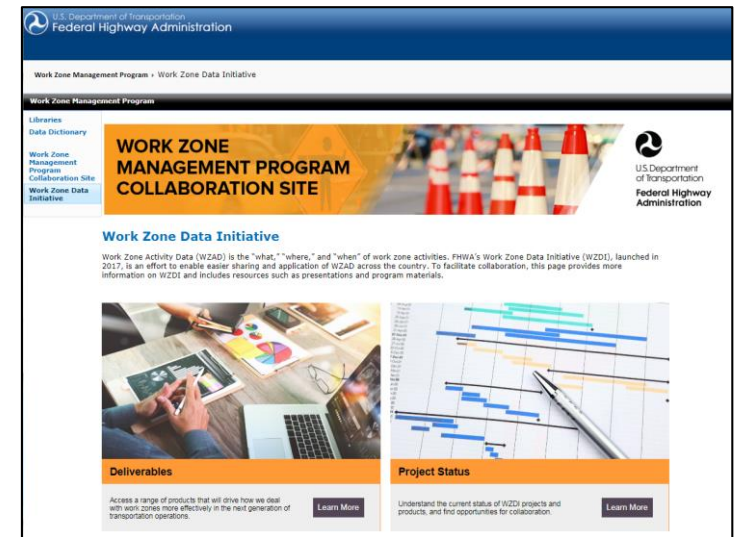
Next Steps
